I. God is Immutable in His Nature.

A. His Attributes Mal. 3:6; Heb. 13:8.

B. His Decree Psa. 148:5,6; Isa. 46:10,11.

II. God's Word is Immutable.

B. The Word's doctrine doesn't change 1 Tim. 5:17;
Titus 1:9; Rom. 1:22,23.

C. Eternal is always relevant Matt. 7:22,24.

III. God is Immutable in His Justice & Mercy.

B. What God hates, He will always hate and judge
